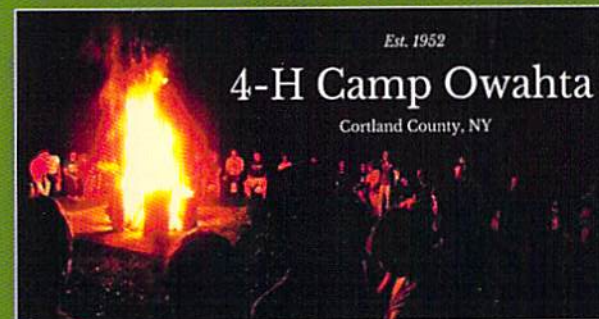
We are located near McGraw, NY
