


Teachers - Quick Start Guide

We have good news! The Children's Health Market has enhanced its website and created some helpful web-based services to assist you in teaching **THE GREAT BODY SHOP**. You are just a few short steps from getting your digital classrooms set up and getting your students online!


1 Go to www.TheGreatBodyShop.net and click on Current Customers. Enter your username and password.



- 2 Click My Materials on the menu bar.
- Click the green bar to **Register New Teacher's Guide (TG)**. Look on the back of your Implementation Guide (blue booklet) for the serial number of your Teacher's Guide(s). Enter just the portion of the serial number before the underscore. If your serial number reads 155318_00, then just enter 155318 in the TG Number field. Once registered, you will be able to view your digital Teacher's Guide and Student Issues.



- Click My Classrooms on the menu bar. Click green bar to Add New Class
- 5 Enter a name for your classroom. Many teachers find incorporating the school year in the name helpful.
- Create one Default Student Password for the entire class. Later, when you add students to your classroom, you will assign a unique Student ID for each student.
- Select a **TG** to use for this classroom. Your TG, which may have an older copyright date is



valid for multiple years, but select the newest TG version to match the current Student Issue.

In your newly created classroom, click on the **Students** button located in the blue bar. Click **+Add New Student...**.

Enter your student's information. Only fields with an * are required. Create a unique Student ID for each student (ex: JSmith). Later, you will have the option of editing each student's password if needed in the "Edit Student" function.

To create custom letters for your students click on the **Print Student Letters** button. Letters include student's credentials and simple instructions for getting online. You have the option of printing

an individual student letter by clicking on the print icon next to the student name.

To provide families access to the Family Portal, click on the **Print Family Letter** button. Families can view THE GREAT BODY SHOP Music, Family Connection Newsletters, and the Student Issues you have assigned.



- 1 1 Click My Instructional Plan on the menu bar.
- 12 Click on the **Assignments** button. Click **+Add New Assignment...**.
- Select the type of Assignment you would like students to have access to (Quiz, Student Issue, or Worksheet). If you assign a Quiz, students can take it online, and the results will automatically be placed in your Gradebook under My Classrooms.
- Set the Start and Due Date for your assignment. Your students will only be able to access these materials during the time frame you set.
- To experience the website as a "student," add yourself as a student in My Classrooms. Then, assign a quiz and take the quiz using your Student ID. Be sure to go back and view your results in the Gradebook.



Recording and Evaluating Implementation

Follow the steps below for recording and evaluating your implementation of THE GREAT BODY SHOP.

Go to www.TheGreatBodyShop.net and click on Current Customers. Enter your username and password as shown, or simply click on the Log in button if info has been auto-generated.



2 Click on My Instructional Plan on the menu bar.

Identify which class received the instruction, and click on the **Instr Log** button.




4 Click on the applicable Instructional Unit.




- Click on the Lesson that you have taught.
- Add notes about the lesson by clicking on the **My Notes** button. Indicate that the lesson has been taught by checking the **Complete** button. Click on the **Evaluate** button to evaluate implementation.
- In the pop up menu, answer the questions provided.
- Click on the **Finished** button.

 If students complete a **Homework** or **Portfolio Activity**, follow the same steps to record and evaluate implementation.

Visit www.thegreatbodyshop.net and click on the **Current Customers** tab to login to your account.

- Unlock access to THE GREAT BODY SHOP by registering your Teacher's Guide under My Materials. If you already have a registered Teacher's Guide, proceed to Step 2.
- Unlock grade level resources for your classroom(s) by assigning your Teacher's Guides.

Under My Classrooms...

- click Add New Class
- name your class and create a Classroom Password
- select the correct grade level
- select the appropriate TG Version
- click Add New Class to save
- Add any Student Issues you would like available in the Family Portal to your classrooms.

- Provide families access to the Family Portal.

Under My Classrooms...

- click Edit
- select a language and click Print Family Letter
- download the letter and distribute




