

# Welcome to 6<sup>th</sup> Grade General Music! (Section 8B)

Dear Parents:

Welcome to the 2021 – 2022 school year! I am thrilled to be your student's 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Music Teacher this year! Below you will find details regarding Google Classroom, masks, rehearsal etiquette, grading policy and concert dates.

## **Google Classroom**

Every student in 6th Grade General Music will need to be part of our Google Classroom.

The class code is: **6cvucmy**

*It is extremely important that everyone sign up for our Google Classroom. In the event that we are no longer able to meet in person and have to go to remote learning, this will be the platform that we use. The Google Classroom "stream" will be used for announcements, links, and any information you may need throughout the course of the year. Assignments, should we go remote again, will appear under the "classwork" tab.*

## **Masks**

Students will be required to follow McGraw's policy when it comes to wearing masks. This means that students will need to wear masks at all times. Once students are seated and we are ready to begin rehearsing, I will inform students to remove their masks so they are able to sing, if they are comfortable doing so. Students will only be allowed to remove their masks when they are six feet apart. If students would rather leave their masks on, they are welcome to do so.

## **Class Format/Rehearsals**

6th Grade General Music will meet during period 8 on B days in the High School Auditorium.

While this class is entitled General Music I believe that part of creating a well-rounded musician involves performing. In this class students will be learning basic musical concepts to lay the groundwork for their musical education in the future through a balance of activities in note reading, improvisation, composition, music listening, music history, as well as singing. With this said, students in 6th Grade General Music will be forming a 6th Grade Chorus that performs on our two annual concerts.

Required Materials: Students are expected to have their music, any handouts, and a pencil for every class.

Rehearsal/Class Etiquette Points: It is imperative that we maximize our rehearsal time by being on task from the moment students walk in the auditorium to the moment students are dismissed. Points will be deducted for inattentiveness, disruption or misbehavior. Students are expected to remove any gum and leave any food/drink in their backpacks. Students will receive two points for rehearsal etiquette each class if these rules are followed.

## Equipment

Due to our class meeting in the High School Auditorium, there will be band equipment, musical sets, props, etc. on the stage. It is extremely important that students do not touch what is not theirs. We want to preserve the life of the new equipment that was purchased. If students are told or asked to touch certain equipment, it is expected that ALL equipment be treated with respect. Please be aware that if I find a student defacing or treating any equipment poorly, that student will be responsible for any damages.

## Recommended Concert Attire

The goal of our concert attire is to present a formal and professional ensemble appearance. No individual in the ensemble should stick out. Please choose dress clothes that reflect this goal.

**Option 1:** Blouse **with sleeves**, black pants or **full-length** skirt, black stockings or socks, black dress shoes.

**Option 2:** Full-length dress, black stockings or socks, black dress shoes

**Option 3:** Dress shirt, black pants, tie, **black socks**, black **dress** shoes.
