The State of New York mandates that health related screening be completed in our schools each year. The requirements are as follows:

- For new entrants:
 - o Vision: Distance Acuity, Near Vision, Hyperopia, Color Perception
 - o Hearing
 - Health Appraisal (Physical)
- Vision Screening: Distance Acuity in Kindergarten and Grades 1, 2, 3, 5, 7 and 10.
- Hearing Screening: Completed in Kindergarten and Grades 1, 3, 5, 7 and 10.
- Scoliosis: Completed in Grades 5 9.
- Health Appraisals: Physicals are also required in Kindergarten and Grades 2, 4, 7 and 10.

If there are any usual findings, or cause for concern, the school nurse will contact you. In the event that additional evaluation is needed, a referral form will be sent home for you to take to your private healthcare provider.

Body Mass Indexes are also required for reporting this year based on physicals in K, 2, 4, 7 and 10th grades. Other than boy or girl and grade no other child specific information is given. If you prefer to not have your child's information given, please send in a written request to the Health Office.

Children need to "learn to be healthy" and need to be "healthy to learn"!
