40 - Purchased Services	<p>Six Flags Darien Lake tickets for 33 students to attend Science, Math, and Physics Day on June 3, 2022. The cost is \$42.98 per student, plus a group processing fee of \$9.99. Throughout the course of the pandemic, students have lost much of their ability to have hands-on science experiences compared to their pre-Covid experiences. This field trip would undeniably allow students to experience some of the science and math phenomena discussed in their classes in a real-life setting. When science is relevant to students, it resonates and allows for a deeper understanding of content. When students ride roller coasters, they are going to have a much greater appreciation and knowledge of acceleration and forces than they would ever get from just sitting in a classroom. Another area in which students have experienced learning loss due to the pandemic is in their social-emotional wellbeing and their abilities to practice the interpersonal and "soft" skills that help them succeed outside of high school. This field trip would get students out of the confines of this academic building and allow them to function in a real-world setting. Students would be required to work collaboratively with their peers, budget their time, communicate effectively with chaperones, and interact appropriately with members of the public and other school districts. For a cohort of students who have spent much of the last two years behind screens, there is a true need to have chances to hone and develop these abilities, and this trip would go a long way in creating such an opportunity.</p>	\$1,428
